From 23 to 25 June

The summer season gets off to an explosive start with around 7000 mountain bikers gathering for this unique opportunity to enjoy the huge Franco-Swiss mountain bike area that is the Portes du Soleil! The atmosphere is fun, friendly and exciting and is the perfect opportunity to explore the enormous mountain-bike domain.

There are over 80 km of varied routes and tracks interspersed with refreshment stops serving local specialities to fuel participants over the three days.

A rich fauna and flora are a big part of the mountains, as are the herds of Abondance cows that keep the age-old traditions alive.

In the immediate area and in neighbouring Switzerland too there are host of unexpected and varied discoveries to be made

1 Abondance Abbey

At an altitude of 930 m this was the most important abbey in the diocese of Geneva in the 12th century.

Maison du Val d'Abondance

Learn all about Abondance cheese and our beautiful Abondance valley and the region.

Exhibition: Return of the Wildlife

The story of how the animal life here has adjusted to human activity, from the arrival of early man to the mountains of today. Maison des Sœurs Convent, La Chapelle d'Abondance.

4 Pont du Diable Gorge

This narrow gorge, part of which runs underground, eroded by the River Dranse in the Aulps Valley through very hard grey marble, is a striking example of the power of erosion.

5 Bex salt mine

A trail several kilometres long explaining the most widely used mining techniques.



6 Le Swiss Vapeur Parc

A miniature delight: 1,500 m of railway track in grounds of 16,000 m². Come and visit Europe's premier railway theme park in Le Bouveret. This attraction is entirely dedicated to the railway and its greatest conquests. A veritable journey through Lilliput, for Gullivers both big and small!

Ies Aigles du Léman

In fun educational shows, Les Aigles du Léman explains all about the biggest predators ever found in the Alps: the eagle and the wolf.

Fondation Gianadda

Permanent and temporary exhibitions, concerts, museum, archaeology trail, etc. Art in context.

The shores of Lake Geneva

Evian - Thonon - Amphion - Yvoire: enjoy the sunshine on the shore of the landlocked sea of Lake Geneva.

10 Les Marécottes Zoo

Alpine zoo at an altitude of 1,100 metres. Covering 35,000 m^2 , this zoo has examples of most of the animal species to be found in the Alps, plus an unusual alpine swimming pool dug out of the rock.

Le Châtelard VS amusement park

Historical funicular railway dating from 1920, the steepest two-car funicular in the world (max. 87%), little scenic Decauville train, views on the move opposite Mont-Blanc, mini-funicular, slide show, museum and Emosson dam.

12 La Mer de Glace

In 20 minutes the cog railway takes you up to the site of the Mer de Glace, France's largest glacier, covering 40 km².

🚑 BY ROAD

From France, follow the autoroute towards Geneva, take the Annemasse exit and follow signs for Thonon.

From Switzerland, follow the autoroute towards Monthey, take the Monthey exit and follow signs for Morgins.

🛪 BY AIR

Geneva Cointrin airport, rail services to Aigle or Thonon, then transfer by bus or taxi.

🚊 BY RAIL

From France, to Thonon station, then transfer by bus or taxi. **From Switzerland**, to Aigle station, then Buski or taxi.
