## Super-Châtel/Linga link

Two detachable chairlifts (a 4-seater and a 6-seater) now connect the Super-Châtel sector with Le Linga. They both start from Vonnes, near Morgins on the Swiss border, taking pressure off the shuttle service and reducing car usage.

And the icing on the cake: the lifts serve brand new pistes that are really worth checking out!

This faster and more practical link enables skiers to get even more out of the fabulous Portes du Soleil ski area, whatever their level.


### Take to the air

Taking to the air will take you slowly but surely closer to the great white paradise...







Trying new snowsports like yoonering and the snakegliss, and why not snowscooting or joining in fun rides with your mates, where everyone contributes their own craziness.




A winter ramble in the morning, a cultural encounter in the afternoon and a restaurant dinner in the evening: you're in for the best time ever!

# Oxfam Wintertrail: a full-on event


In Châtel and the Abondance Valley on 4 and 5 March 2017, experience an event you'll find nowhere else in the world: a charity walk on snowshoes!

This event, organised in partnership with the Abondance Valley Community of Communes, is to raise funds for Oxfam, a charity that works to alleviate poverty all over the world.


Around 400 people are expected to take part, on the mountainside above the valley.

BY ROAD

From France, follow the autoroute towards Geneva, take the Annemasse exit and follow signs for Thonon.

From Switzerland, follow the autoroute towards Monthey, take the Monthey exit and follow signs for Morgins.

Geneva Cointrin airport, rail services to Aigle or Thonon,

**From France**, to Thonon station, then transfer by bus or taxi. **From Switzerland**, to Aigle station, then Buski or taxi.
